

ProSoft Technology Statement on the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h)

ProSoft Technology is continually assessing our compliance with current and upcoming regulations including the requirements of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA). Under the TSCA, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published five final rules on January 6, 2021 to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bio-accumulative, and toxic (PBT). The rules limit or prohibit the manufacture, import, processing, and distribution in commerce (including within articles) of the following PBT chemicals:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate 3:1 (PIP 3:1)
- 2, 4, 6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2, 4, 6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

ProSoft Technology is working closely with supply chain partners to assure compliance to restricted material requirements of all products and materials supplied by partners. To the best of our knowledge none of the PBT chemicals listed above are intentionally used in manufacturing processes or added to our products.
